Converting a Decimal to a Fraction

To convert a decimal to a fraction you:

- 1) Determine the denominator by counting the number of digits to the right of the decimal point.
- 2) The numerator is the number to the right of the decimal point.
- 3) Reduce.

Example

Convert .52 to a fraction.

$$.52 = \frac{52}{100}$$
$$= \frac{13}{25}$$
